



National Allied Golf Associations Update – May 25, 2021 (updated)

Dear Members,

The Province of Manitoba has provided clarification to the current public health order restrictions that are in effect until Saturday, May 29 at 12:01 a.m.:

- Outdoor gatherings with anyone from outside a household are no longer allowed and this applies to all recreation spaces including golf courses. **This means that golf is permitted to be played only with members of your immediate household.**

NOTE: Within the Public Health Order, golfers are NOT ALLOWED to golf with their one designated visitor.

- Only one person per household will be allowed to enter a business (pro shop).
