



National Allied Golf Associations Update – September 2, 2021

The Province of Manitoba announced today new [public health orders](#) which will be in effect as of Friday, September 3rd at 12:01 a.m.

Proof of vaccination will be required for:

- Restaurants (indoor and patio dining),
- All licensed premises,
- Indoor sporting and recreational facilities (excluding youth recreational sport for persons under 18 years of age) including fitness centres and gyms, and
- Organized indoor group recreational classes and activities, and indoor recreational business.

Wedding receptions held in licensed premises will be subject to the same rules as restaurants and licensed premises, and guests will have to show proof of vaccination. There will be a grace period to September 7th to allow individuals to adjust their plans.

These new orders include reducing the maximum number of people allowed at outdoor gatherings to 500, down from the current limit of 1,500.

Within the new order, mask use remains mandatory at all indoor public places.

Children born after December 31st, 2009 who are not eligible to be immunized will be able to attend events and activities with a fully-immunized adult.
