Ada Mackenzie 1891 - 1973



- Ada Mackenzie's record as a competitive golfer is well known throughout Canada.
- Some of Ada's accomplishments include:
 - Founder of the only Canadian golf club for women (The Toronto Ladies' Golf Club).
 - The first retail shop in Toronto devoted to sportswear for women.
 - She won the Canadian Open 5 times and the Canadian Closed 5 times during the years from 1919 1950.
 - Elected to the Canadian Golf Hall of Fame in 1971.
 - Elected to the Canadian Amateur Athletic Hall of Fame in 1972.
- Ada contributed immensely to the game of golf and is remembered by many for the encouragement she provided to young golfers.
- To recognize her contribution to golf, an annual **<u>NET</u>** event was established in her honour.
- Proceeds from the event will be used for women's player development initiatives.
