

Motorized Transportation Policy for Competitions

Players are permitted to use Motorized carts in all events except the Junior Bantam Championship, Junior Interclub Championship and the Junior Provincial Championship.

Parents & Spectators will not be allowed to ride a cart unless a Permanent Disability Placard is shown to the Golf Manitoba Tournament Director. Letters from doctors or visible injuries will not warrant a golf cart without a placard.

Use of Motorized Transportation by a Competitor or Caddie is subject to the following conditions: When using motorized transportation, the player or caddie must not:

- Permit anyone else to drive the cart (other than moving it a very short distance to facilitate play)
- Are not permitted to travel with their motorized cart beyond the point on the course where their ball lies to gauge yardage or to seek the position of the hole.

Use of Motorized Transportation

Golf Manitoba has the right to limit motorized carts to 2 carts per pairing if they deem necessary

In the event a competitor or caddie is in breach of any of the above conditions, the Golf Manitoba Tournament/Rules Committee may assess any or all of the following penalties for each hole at which any breach occurs:

- verbal warning from referee, Director of Competitions or Committee sanction
- one stroke penalty
- general penalty
- disqualification
