

RESPECT IN SPORT POLICY

Purpose of the Policy:

- Golf Manitoba is committed to creating a sport environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity. Coaches have a responsibility to create a sporting environment that is free of harassment and abuse.
- 2. Golf Manitoba requires that all coaches participating in golf complete the Respect in Sport (RIS) program and maintain RIS certified status (5-year term) as required by Sport Manitoba.

Scope and Application:

- 3. The policy applies to all coaches registered with; or named on an official sport roster; or under the jurisdiction of Golf Manitoba.
- 4. Any coach not having completed the RIS program or maintained certified status in the timeframe established by Sport Manitoba and Golf Manitoba may be removed as a coach until such time that the RIS course is completed and/or maintain RIS certification.

Enforcement:

Non-compliance of this policy may result in further discipline as determined by the Board of Directors or in accordance with the Discipline & Complaints Policy.

Review and Approval:

This policy was approved by the Board of Directors and will be reviewed by the Executive Committee on an annual basis.
