Hello Junior Golfer,

We are excited to announce that the sport of Golf will again be included in the 2024 Manitoba Summer Games powered by Manitoba Hydro. Multisport Games provide an opportunity for the Manitoba's developing athletes, coaches and officials to participate in a multisport event in preparation for a higher level of competition. A chance to represent their communities and compete for the province of Manitoba. Like the Olympics, these multi-sport games take place every four years with the next one being held August 11-17, 2024, in Dauphin, Manitoba.

Golf Manitoba would like to make you aware of the Manitoba Summer Games powered by Manitoba Hydro Regional Training Squad program for the 2023/24 golf season. To be eligible for the training squad and the Games, participants must be 16 years old or younger (boys) and 17 years old or younger (girls) as of August 17, 2024.

Five different regions will have access to coaching by a PGA of Canada golf professional (see coaching staff below) commencing in the late summer/early fall of this year and carrying over into 2024. Each Training Squad Member will receive approximately 15 hours of coaching/training in preparation for the team qualifier (date and locations TBD be each coach) to represent their region in the 2024 Manitoba Summer Games powered by Manitoba Hydro.
