The primary objectives are to support Golf Manitoba in the delivery of introductory junior golf programs in the Golf Manitoba region including Golf in Schools, Junior Mobile Clinics and Junior Skills Challenge. The position will also support the Director of Competitions & Rules in conducting 15 provincial amateur golf championships.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting to the Executive Director, the successful candidate(s) will be a highly motivated team player, with excellent verbal and written communication skills. The ability to deliver high quality customer service to all partners, members, member facilities, and players while working with diverse groups of staff and volunteers is essential.

The position will require some travel throughout Manitoba and Northwest Ontario and some evening and weekend work. Candidates should present a professional and mature attitude in dealing with program participants, members, spectators, golf course professionals, sponsors, and other staff.
