- The facility must submit their report before **August 31**. Any unused grants will automatically be forfeited and allocated to a different facility after this date.
- Golf Manitoba will issue grant cheques once your junior programs have been completed and your reports have been submitted. The facility can expect to receive a cheque within 2 to 4 weeks
