



MOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION POLICY FOR COMPETITIONS

Competitors

- Motorized carts are **permitted** for competitors in all events.
- **Exception:** Motorized carts are **NOT** permitted in the **Junior Provincial Championships** and the **U15 Championship**.

Parents & Spectators

- Spectator carts are **permitted** with a **valid medical reason** or at the **discretion of the host venue and/or tournament committee**, and fees will apply. You must follow the minimum distance and prohibited areas rules set out in the **Parent Spectator Policy**. Violators will be asked to leave, and carts will be removed.

Use of Motorized Transportation by a Competitor or Caddie is subject to the following conditions:

When using motorized transportation, the player or caddie must not:

- Permit anyone else to drive the cart (other than moving it a very short distance to facilitate play)
- Are not permitted to travel with their motorized cart beyond the point on the course where their ball lies to gauge yardage or to seek the position of the hole.

Use of Motorized Transportation

- Golf Manitoba has the right to limit motorized carts to 2 carts per pairing if they deem necessary.

In the event a competitor or caddie is in breach of any of the above conditions, the Golf Manitoba Tournament/Officials Committee may assess any or all of the following penalties for each hole at which any breach occurs. Please keep in mind that breach of the rule will be cumulative for the 2026 season:

- Verbal warning from referee, Director of Competitions or Committee sanction
- One stroke penalty
- General penalty (two-stroke penalty)
- Disqualification

CARTS ARE NOT GUARANTEED TO BE AVAILABLE BY THE HOST CLUB OR GOLF MANITOBA
